

Observation protocol cards

<p>You find out that the observer described your lesson to another colleague afterwards.</p>	<p>The person who is scheduled to observe you asks if the observation can be postponed. S/he tells you one hour before the lesson is due to start.</p>	<p>The observer chats to some of the students during some of the groupwork activities in your lesson.</p>
<p>The observer comes over to talk to you during one of the free practice activities.</p>	<p>You find out that the observer described a very successful activity you used to another colleague.</p>	<p>The observer asks you for a lesson plan to look at.</p>
<p>The observer interrupts and points out a mistake you made on the board.</p>	<p>After the lesson, the observer doesn't mention the lesson or say what they thought.</p>	<p>The observer leaves before the lesson has ended.</p>
<p>You have an odd number of students for a pairwork activity. The observer volunteers to make up the numbers and work with one of the students.</p>	<p>The observer arrives a few minutes after the lesson has started.</p>	<p>One of the students wants to ask the observer a question.</p>
