Session 5.1: The dangers of illegal drugs

Activity sheet 5.1.1: Legal and illegal drugs

Some drugs are **legal**. This means you are allowed to have them. Some drugs are **illegal**. This means you are not allowed to have them. It is against the law.

Activity sheet 5.1.2a: The possible bad effects of drugs

If you take drugs that are illegal they can do you harm.

Activity sheet 5.1.2b: Mental illness and illegal drugs

Activity sheet 5.1.3: The risks of taking drugs

Different drugs harm you in different ways.

Activity 5.1.4: Where do people sell drugs?

Sometimes you can be in danger if you go to places where people are selling illegal drugs.

Talk about why these places are dangerous.



Activity sheet 5.1.5: Drugs and money

Illegal drugs can cost a lot of money. You can get into lots of money problems. Talk about what would happen if you are spending money on illegal drugs.



Activity sheet 5.1.6: Drugs and your relationships



Illegal drugs can affect other areas of your life.

Think of how they can affect your relationships.



Think of how they can affect your work or other activities.

Think of one other area that they can affect.

Activity sheet 5.1.7: Saying no to drugs

Sometimes a friend or a stranger may offer you a tablet. They may say that it will make you happy or relaxed. You must say 'no' as it can do you a lot of harm and it is **illegal**.

If you feel unhappy or agitated and you think you need the drug you can talk to your doctor about it. It is better to get help from your doctor or support worker rather than taking an **illegal** drug.

Role-play saying 'no' to illegal drugs.

You can say 'no' and then walk away.

Role-play asking your doctor or support worker for help.

You may have been taking drugs. You can still get help.



Activity sheet 5.1.8: Reporting illegal drugs
